

Apple Valley Campground Rules



1. All guests **MUST** be registered when entering campground.
2. Only 1 RV and 2 cars per site.
3. Speed limit is **5mph** throughout the campground.
4. Vehicles **MUST BE** parked on your site and roads must be clear for normal traffic or emergency vehicles. **Only 2 vehicles per site at ALL times.** Extra vehicles, boats ,trailers will be charged \$5.00 per day and **MUST BE** parked in storage area, but **DO NOT** park or drive on the grass.
5. Pets must be on a leash at all times. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after them and keeping them quiet. **DO NOT** leave pets unattended. Pets are **NOT** allowed in the pool area, store, Rec Hall, bathroom/laundry areas.
6. No fireworks, fire arms, knives, bow and arrows, etc. are permitted.
7. Illegal drugs & misuses of alcohol beverages will **NOT** be tolerated. Marijuana is prohibited in the campground. Driving while intoxicated in the campground is strictly prohibited and you will be asked to leave without a refund.
8. Please Note: trail bikes, 3 & 4 wheelers motorized skateboards, battery operated ride-on kids vehicles, etc. are **NOT** permitted in the campground. Mopeds & golf carts are allowed with the following restrictions:
 - Operated by licensed drivers only!!
 - Proof of liability insurance must be presented to the office **before they may be operated.** Liability coverage must be in the amount of \$500K or more.
 - Mopeds are restricted to **one** person and golf carts may not exceed the manufacturer recommended seating capacity.
 - No standing up
 - Remove keys when not in operation.
 - Golf carts **MUST** have at least 3" site numbers posted on them.
 - Golf carts and mopeds may **NOT** be driven after **DUSK!!** Drive only on campground roadways - **5mph.**
9. One person per bike. Bikes are not to be ridden after **DUSK!** The driveway area is **NOT** to be used for biking, roller blading, roller skating, etc. **Helmets required** by State of Maine law.
10. No walking or driving across other's campsites.
11. No trees, rocks, grass, fireplaces or site numbers should be altered in any way without permission from the office.
12. In order to prevent damage to underground water, cable and power lines, no digging on sites is allowed without permission from the office.
13. **NO** excessive water use on the weekends (sprinklers). Washing of vehicles is prohibited. Gray water is **NOT** to be dumped on the ground. It should be taken to the dumping station.

14. Fires may not exceed 3 feet in height from the ground at any time. Fires are not to be left unattended. Burn only clean, untreated wood. Do not burn trash or put trash in fireplaces.
15. Please put trash in the dumpster near the dumping station. Do not leave trash on the ground. **Only bagged household trash is acceptable** - NO metal, wood, chairs, microwaves, tv's, tarps, plant pots, furniture grills etc. This is to be brought back home with you to be disposed of. Small cardboard is allowed but please flatten all cardboard boxes. If you have something questionable, please ask before you just leave it the camera sees all.
16. No swings are allowed on sites.
17. All children under the age of 12 **MUST BE** accompanied by an adult in the restrooms. Cleanliness of restrooms is encouraged. Please report any problems to the office.
18. If you wish to have your propane tank filled, please pay in the office and then leave it at the propane filling station labeled with name & site number.
19. Children's play areas include the game field, rec hall and the swimming pool. Children are NOT to be playing in the bath houses or surrounding areas. The store porch is **NOT** a play area!!!
20. **Pool hours are:** 9am - 8pm. daily. Children under 14 must have **an adult 18** or older with them to supervise. No life guard on duty.
Game room hours are: Sun - Thurs 8am-10pm. Fri- Sat 8am-10pm.
Quiet hours are: Sun - Thurs 10pm-8am. Fri- Sat 11pm-8 am.
(Motorcycles owners **please be** considerate of your neighbors).
All children must be on their site during these times!
21. Cleanliness of sites should be maintained at all times.
22. Campers will be liable for any damages incurred by themselves or their guests. You are responsible to make sure your guest have registered in the office. Overnight guest must leave at quiet hours if not registered in the office by 8:00 P.M.
23. Courteous manners are expected at all times and in all places!!!!
24. Failures to abide by any of the above rules will result in the loss of camping privileges without a refund.
